Hughes and is pleased to see the structure 97% completed. The project's focus is now largely on the internal-works for the conference areas as well as the 60 new guest rooms. The next milestone for the 80-strong team, says Hirini, will be "power-on" for the site: The electrical sub-contractor is Ward Chandler. Having power and reducing the need for long extension cables makes a big difference to the crew. Hirini and Ashley Schierhout, Project Manager from Jet Park Hotel reflect on weather being one of the challenges in the construction to date.

The construction crew, including sub-contractors enjoyed what they said was "one of the best shouts" they've had on a site. The hotel's F&B and Front Office Managers cooked prawns, steak, and large German bratwurst sausages, and everyone enjoyed a well-deserved break from the hard work which began in February 2015 to bring the project to this point ... How Can You Help?

- You may wish to help save water by turning off the tap tightly and avoiding leaving water running.
- If you are staying with us for several days, please feel free to decline a towel change from our housekeepers.
- Please leave any recyclable waste e.g. paper, newspaper, magazines, any glass or plastic bottles beside the bin in your room to be included in our recycling system.
- Room key cards: These are designed to control the lights in your room, so that when you're out, lights are off to save power. You may also wish to consider turning off your TV and heating/cooling too, when not in the room.
- If you're walking on New Zealand's beautiful trails/bush walks, always wear clean shoes and use shoe spray stations to prevent the spread of 'Kauri Die Back Disease'.

Our Unique Local Environment

We have planted the hotel grounds in native vegetation including Flax, Cabbage Trees, Manuka, and Kowhai. These attract native bird life to the site and create a small 'green belt' in a fast-developing industrial area. Please feel free to enjoy a stroll around our grounds! Our Concierge team also have a lot of information on great local walks or bike trails- we even have bikes for hire!



Did You Know? The kokako is one of NZ's endangered and endemic (that is, found only in New Zealand) birds. A joint project between the Auckland City Council and Department of Conservation, The Kokako Project was created to protect and save the kokako. Jet Park Hotel is proud to be a part of this project.
